- 1st F/L Firmston-Williams, F/L Clark, Sgt Williamson.
A job with the fish-heads! A sailor with mouth injuries (he didn't let on as to how he got his injuries) was lifted from the fishery protection vessel LINDISFARNE to Hull RI.
- 3rd F/L Sandford, F/L Whittaker, Sgt Williamson.
A Mayday on 243 was heard in the ops room & eventually established as coming from a Tornado 20 nm NE of Binbrook. On arrival, parachutes and a miniflare were spotted and a Buccaneer orbited the crash site. One survivor, a student pilot, was found in a field with some of the local population and the staff pilot was eventually traced & recovered from the village surgery. Both were taken to Binbrook to be checked by the MO before being further transferred to Ely.
- 5th F/L Sandford, F/L Whittaker, Sgt Williamson.
Search with CG and police of Kilnsea- Spurn Head area for missing 8 year old boy. He re-appeared 12 hours later under his own steam.
- 6th F/L Sandford, F/L Whittaker, Sgt Williamson.
Search of the River Trent from Trent Falls to Westockwith after three youths entered the river in a car at Owston Ferry. The car was still there but there was no sign of the boys.
- 9th F/O Wolfendale, F/L Whittaker, F/S Murrant.
Search along the Bempton cliffs for possible occupants of a car reported going over the top. Lots of debris but no bodies found.
- 11th F/L Best, S/L Corby, Sgt Williamson, F/L Boothby.
Search for 13 year old boy washed into the sea off Scarborough North Bay. Scarborough LB and IRB assisted search with high tide and a very rough sea close to shore. Nothing found.
- 15th F/L Firmston-Williams, F/L Whittaker, Sgt Williamson.
Search for Humber Bridge jumper, curtailed by failing light. Nothing found.
- 7th F/L Best, S/L Corby, MACR Samwell.
Medevac of Tornado crew from Leconfield to Ely after they were delivered here by a Boulmer Sea King that had originally picked them up from the crash site.
- 15th F/L Best, S/L Corby, MACR Samwell.
The skipper of FV MONICA B was lifted with a crushed hand from a position 75nm NE of Leconfield & transferred to Scarborough Hospital.
